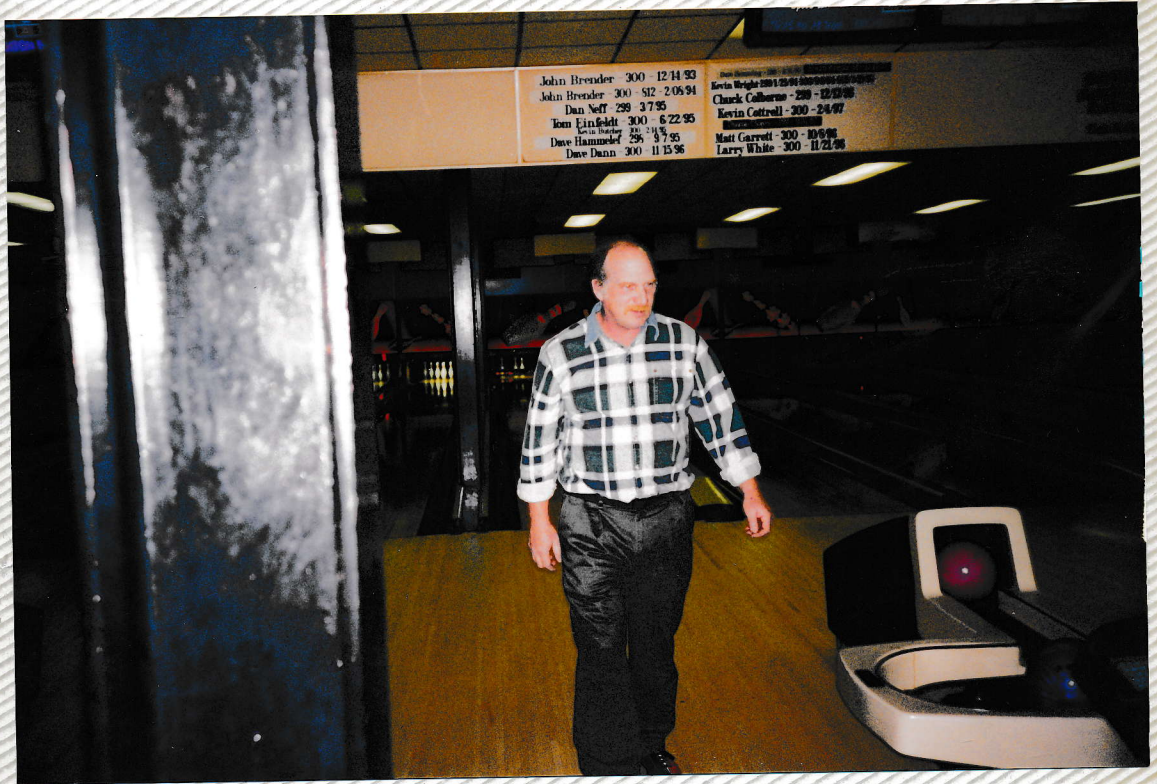
Social Activity:

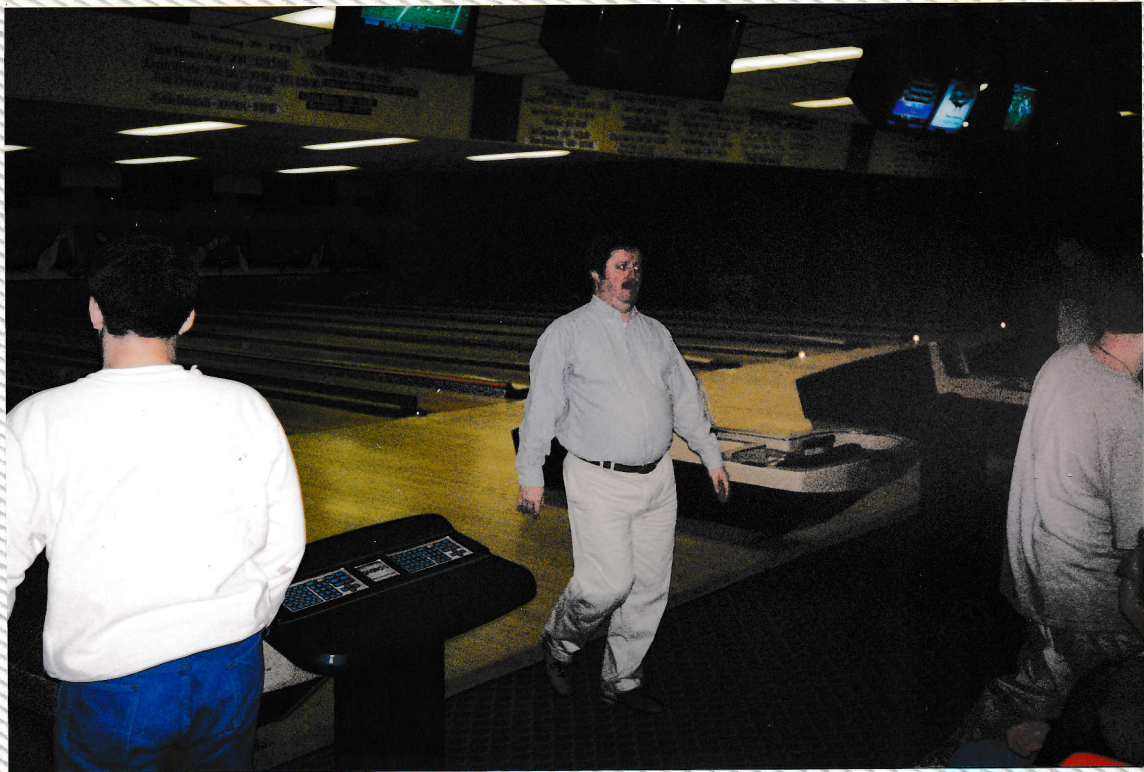
