## Term Limitation Petition Drive

Across the nation and locally, many libertarians and supporters of the "The Throw the Bums Out" movement are sponsoring a petition drive to limit political terms. Specifically, U.S. House of Representatives limited to 3 terms in 12 years, U.S. Senate limited to 2 terms in 24 years, state representatives limited to 3 terms, state senators to 2 terms, and governors, lt. governors, and attorneys general to 2 terms.
